Double Major Program Requirements.

Students of this department can make double major programs with the departments mentioned above.

It is opened for successful students enrolled in a undergraduate program at the University to continue with another program within the University and obtain a second license certificate if they wish and are accepted. The double major program must have a minimum credit load of 30 credits in addition to the total credit of the major program, provided that both major programs meet the total credit hours required for graduation and other requirements of these programs. The double major program can be applied at the earliest in the third and fifth semesters of the registered program. In faculties with an education period of more than four years (eight semesters), the double major program can be applied in the seventh semester at the latest. In order for a student to be accepted as a double major, he / she has successfully completed all the courses he / she has taken in his / her major program until the application period.

Having a minimum grade point average of 3.00 in the major program at the time of application for the major program (3.5 points out of 4 students who apply for a double major with a scholarship) and having a placement score not less than the base point of the program to be made in the double major and aptitude test. The student must be successful in the talent exam in admitting students to the double major program. Registration for more than one second major program cannot be made at the same time. However, it is possible to enroll in a minor program with a second major diploma at the same time. The student in the double major program can transfer to the second major diploma program horizontally when the student meets the conditions in the higher education institution in the major program. During the double major education, the student's second major grade point average may decrease to 2.50 for once. The student whose grade point average falls below 2.50 for the second time is deleted from the second major diploma program. In order to graduate from the second major program, the grade point average of the second major must be at least 2.70 and the graduation requirements of the programs must be met. It is given to the student who attends the double program if he / she graduates from the second major diploma or the first major program. Students who have completed the major program but have shortcomings from the second major program may have a maximum of two years of study, with the decision of the board of directors of the faculty where the second major diploma program is located.

The semester can be extended. However, if an extension is required in double major programs with a high credit load, an additional two-semester extension can be given. From the undergraduate program he / she is registered with

A second undergraduate diploma is awarded to the student who achieves the right to graduate and completes the double major program.
