Minor Program Requirement.

Students of this Department can make minor with the departments mentioned above under the following conditions.

It is opened for successful students who are enrolled in an undergraduate program at the University to continue with another program within the University to receive a minor certificate if they wish and are accepted.

If there is no minor program at the moment, a new minor program can be opened under the condition of acceptance according to the student demand. Minor program should have at least 21 credit load in addition to the major courses. Minor program can be applied at the earliest in the third and sixth semesters of the registered program. Teaching period is more than four years (eight semesters) excluding preparatory class

minor programs can be applied to at the latest in the eighth semester. In order for a student to be admitted to a minor program:

Having successfully completed all of the courses taken, the minimum grade point average of the major program at the time of application for the Minor program is 2.50

grade point average of students who apply is 3.25 out of 4) Students cannot register for more than one second major program at the same time. However, it is possible to enroll in a minor program with a second major diploma at the same time. In order to continue the minor program, the GPA must be at least 2.30 in the major program. The student who fails to meet this requirement will be deregistered

from the minor program. The student who does not take courses from the minor program for two consecutive semesters is deleted from the minor program. In order to obtain a minor certificate, the GPA must be at least 2.30. A minor is given to the student who attends the minor program, if he / she graduates from the first major program. The education period of the students who have completed the major program and who are missing from the minor program can be extended for a maximum of two semesters upon the decision of the board of the faculty where the minor program is located. A minor certificate is given to the student who has obtained the right to graduate from the undergraduate program he enrolled in and successfully completed the minor program.
